Can you see anything in your records that would explain an uptick in PM10 3/30-3/31 or 5/11-5/12?

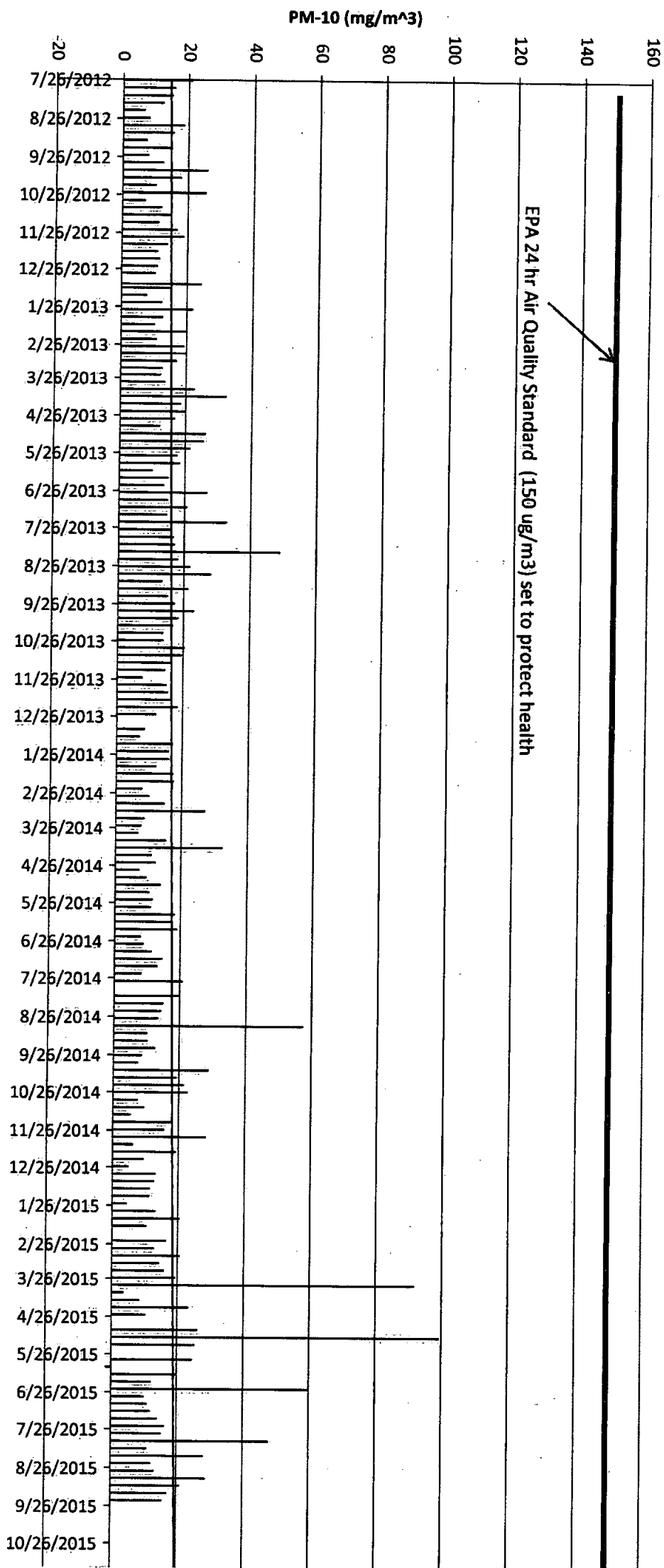
Weren't they still working on the sewer line replacement at that time?
