Norfolk, Virginia, known as the Lambert's Point Terminal ("Facility"). On June 16, 1997 DEQ compliance staff and noted a sniall waste incinerator that was smok-ing. At the time of the inspection, Norfolk Westem staff indicated that the incinerator would no longer be used. On December 3, 2007, DEQ compliance staff re-inspected the Facility and noted the incinerator was in use and the emissions were at 20% opacity.

On December 19, 1997, DEQ issued a Notice of Violation ("NOV") to Norfolk West em for the above deficiencies. Norfolk Westem entered into an Order by Consent ("Order") effective March 2, 1998 to r esolve the NOV. The Order required Norfolk Westem to pay a civil charge of \$1,356.00 and subniit documentation stating th at the incinerator will no longer be used. The \$1356.00 civil charge as well as the documentation statin- that the incinerator would no longer be used was received by DEQ on March II, 1998.
