## IV. COMMENTS

The visit was made to determine whether the amount of water used on the dumper could be reduced with one particular coal that routinely has a very high moisture content, 9% or higher. They demonstrated car dumping with various water sprays turned on: 1) all, 2) overhead only, 3) under only, 4) both doors (2 vertical and 1 horizontal each), 5) both doors (horizontal). There was little difference in visible emissions. The decision was made to allow #4 above. There was minimal dust generated inside the building, less than experienced at DTA the previous day during the inspection. With the fine mist covering the door ways, there would be little impact on the environment. Also, they can turn on a roof spray as needed to control any dust that might escape from the roof ridge vent. They use that spray sometimes with very dry coal.


